THINGS TO SEE AND DO:

- Lake Conroe offers outdoor enjoyment including fishing, boating, and dining options on the lake. Several fishing tournaments are also held on Lake Conroe.
- Lone Star Monument and Historical Flag Park is an educational park and outdoor museum celebrating the state flags which flew over Texas; there are also several monuments.
- Outdoor activities include golfing, water sports, and biking. Sam Houston National Forest and W. Goodrich Jones State Forest offer plenty for the nature enthusiast, including hiking and birding. The city has several parks and aquatics and recreation centers.
- **Downtown Conroe** has two historic theaters with performances throughout the year, art galleries, unique shopping opportunities, restaurants, live music venues, and festivals.
- **Dining options from Conroe to The Woodlands** are plenty, including several local wineries and breweries that offer tours and tastings. Farmer's Markets offer local grown food and products.
- **Houston and Galveston** are close by with Galveston just 90 miles south. The Woodlands also offers shopping, concerts, art festivals, entertainment, dining, parks, and more.

- Montgomery County is the birthplace of the Lone Star flag! Dr. Charles B. Stewart of Montgomery designed the flag and it was adopted by the Republic of Texas in 1839.
